


109 teams registered 100 were active

Six teams raised over \$10,000




EVENT STATISTICS - INDIVIDUALS

INTERNAL CHALLENGES

- More signage + course marshals on the route was needed
- People not reading their emails/SMS about the day
- Permissions from councils were a struggle
- Additional staff at start line to process registrations quicker
- Rethink the VIP finish line as the BBQ was so popular that a number of VIPs enjoyed that rather than using the VIP space
- Rethink the t-shirts and potentially giving all walkers one or people can purchase them as part of the registration payment, as the sea of red was great for photo opportunities and branding along the course
- More sponsors on board to take part in activations along the course
- Look at our budget and have more photographers on course if we don't get enough volunteers




