Foodbank Qld

- A Queensland without Hunger
- By providing the most food to the most people in need in the most efficient & effective ways



Bush Fires 2019-20

- People wanted to help!
- ▶ \$640million raised
 - ▶ Red Cross raised \$242 million
- ► And Foodbank raised.... \$20,000



Foodbank - Tins

- Lines to donate tins
- The team were frantically busy



Reflection?

- Were tins meeting our mission?
- Capacity was maxed!
- ▶ 30% of Tins donated were wasted!



Covid began!

- Lockdowns began
- No tins
- Demand was highest ever seen



What was next?

- ▶ \$1 Donated = 2 meals
- Versus FTE needed
- High Wastage
- Not meeting mission



Tins to Funds

- Retain new cash donors
- ▶ \$1 raised = 2 Meals
- Move from Tins to Funds


Plan for growth

- Personal outreach




Results
