Our Community Fundraisers are critical to fuelling MIA's ongoing work, and this role represents an opportunity to play a proactive role in addressing one of Australia's most critical health issues.

The *Community Fundraising Manager* is responsible for managing MIA's national Community Fundraising program. The position is the primary point of contact for all our passionate community fundraisers, with responsibility including providing assistance in utilising MIA's Community Fundraising Portal to maximise the success of their events.

The successful candidate will love engaging with communities across Australia, and will gain immense satisfaction from seeing their fundraising events come to life. Experience with use of the Salesforce platform is desirable, as is previous experience in a NFP and working with events and/or in fundraising.

This is a 0.6FTE position, based at MIA's WA office in Cottesloe. There is potential for some work-from-home component. The position will work closely with MIA's WA Partnerships & Events Manager, as well as other members of our national Community & Engagement team.

There is also the opportunity to participate in salary packaging arrangements that are offered to employees in the not-for-profit sector.
