

Our values are:


Openness (No secrets)

In 2017, there was a turning point in the trajectory of fundraising at Wayside.

Revenue was just under \$2.7M and heavily reliant on major donors.

We had built up a strong community of supporters who believed in the 'why' of what we do.




Growth since 2016...

^{*}In FY21, Wayside Chapel moved to a new reporting period (April to March) so the FY21 accounting year was 9-months. For consistency in this graph, the revenue in FY21 is a full 12months, incorporating Q1 of FY22.
