The Philanthropy Services Manager forms part of the F&P Management Team and is a key player in the development of future strategy and problem solving. will bring demonstrated experience in developing and implementing best practice policies, procedures and business processes to improve efficiencies for the F&P Department. This role has a strong customer service focus, and acts as a liaison with many WEHI departments (Finance, Information Technology, Research Grants and Development, and Governance Risk and Compliance, etc.) to provide accurate and timely information about F&P operations, and to improve business decision-making processes that are essential for F&P programs.

This role is ideally suited to an advancement/philanthropy services professional with previous experience working in fundraising operations for a medical research institute, university, hospital or similar.

You will be a skilled and experienced user of Raiser's Edge (RE) and RE NXT, and able to demonstrate a strong understanding of how to support a multifaceted philanthropy strategy, including major gifts, bequests, trusts and foundations, community fundraising, mass appeals, regular giving and alumni relations.

Strong analytical skills and financial management skills are essential to generate sophisticated reporting suites to help drive business processes and to inform decision making. Highly developed interpersonal skills and the ability to communicate respectfully with a broad range of stakeholders is essential.
